3. Unfinished Business

Laurita Winery was investigated for the celebration and the price is considered too high. Cedar Gardens will be investigated by Sue.

Spirituality Committee ministry is going well and a movie night is being planned.

A book rack was discussed and funding may be available from the diocese.

There was a discussion of mass schedule for the new church and at present we will keep the current Sunday schedule of 3 masses and have one mass on Saturday.

4. New Church Construction Project

The classrooms are 100% painted. Storm drainage is complete. Finish work is being delayed waiting for activation of the heating systems to reduce the chance of shrinkage. Permanent power is installed. The gas line installation is progressing with completion expected by end of next week. The sprinkler building foundation and tank foundation are poured. A variance was obtained and memorialized by the township for the sprinkler building. Contractors are being held to Dec 19, 2008 completion date. It is important that the building be completed by the end of the year to avoid extra charges. Site lighting is installed. Landscaping will need to be done next year. There is a possibility of obtaining a large tree. This tree can be decorated. Council approves trying to obtain this tree. Sue will lead a committee to determine a site location.

The steeple on the old church will be fixed because the equipment can be shared with what is being used at the new church and this will save money.
