A company will be brought in to show memorial options to the council so that options can be discussed as to the type of memorial that will be used.

### 4. New Church Construction Project

Bill Wilson, the diocesan construction officer, visited the new church this past week and he recommends not having the dedication on Feb 22. Bill's suggestion was based on the fact that the first portion of the dedication ceremony will occur outdoors. The dedication should be held in warmer weather and when at least some landscaping is in place. The dedication will be rescheduled for the spring based on his recommendation.

The ceiling is about 80% completed in the worship space. The Altar platform is waiting for inspection. The class room wing is complete except for punch list items. Arches over the front door were not correct; correct parts are expected this week. The slab is poured in the sprinkler building, the masonry is complete, and interior wall work will begin this week. The frozen ground is delaying the septic system.
