### 2. Unfinished Business

Three bids were received for paving and John Dawkins will review the bids to insure they are a valid comparison. There are differences in the processes being proposed and this makes the comparison necessary. The recommendation from two large paving companies is to not seal the new parking lot. The new parking lot will not be sealed.

No progress on having an ushers meeting but Father Joe did report that a good job is being done of keeping the doors closed between the narthex and worship space. The outside doors and air lock doors should also not be locked open. This will be discussed with the ushers to insure that the doors remain closed to save the heating / air conditioning.

Deacon Ray stated that the Memorial Wall is in progress and there is meeting this week.

### 3. NEW BUSINESS

Beth Kimmick is willing to run a preschool program. A flyer was distributed to determine interest in a preschool. The Finance committee is positive about the idea. Father Joe asked that a 6 member committee be formed to structure the program. Peggy, Jack, Jerry and Yovone agreed to serve on this committee along with two members of the finance committee. A play ground may need to be built and the shed will be repositioned after this is decided.
